On **17/18 December 2020**, the Max Planck Institute for Innovation and Competition will organize the

3rd Research on Innovation, Science and Entrepreneurship Workshop

The goal of the **RISE3 Workshop** is to stimulate an in-depth discussion of a select number of empirical research papers. It offers **Ph.D. students and Junior Post-docs** an opportunity to present their work and to receive feedback.

Overview

The **RISE3 Workshop** will focus on the following areas:

- Science of Science
- Knowledge Diffusion
- Innovation and Entrepreneurship
- Intellectual Property Rights
- Innovation Motives & Behavior

The **RISE3 Workshop** will feature a keynote lecture and 10 paper presentations. Each paper is discussed by a senior researcher with particular emphasis on the research design and the ability to identify causal relationships. Ideally, the workshop venue will be the Max Planck Institute for Innovation and Competition in Munich. However, we will be prepared to switch to an online version of the workshop in case the COVID-19 pandemic shows a negative development.

Acceptance notifications will be announced by **end of September 2020** and the workshop registration will be open until **30 October 2020**. The full paper version of your submission is due on **1 December 2020**.

Provided that the workshop takes place in Munich, a limited number of travel grants will be offered for researchers who do not receive financial conference assistance from their home institution. Please indicate in your application whether the participation is contingent on receiving a travel grant.
